FutureLife-Now! Health Coordinator - Malawi

MIET AFRICA requires a Health Coordinator to support the implementation of the FutureLife-Now! programme in Malawi.

FutureLife-Now! is a regional school-based programme aimed at reducing new HIV infections and increasing ART adherence amongst young people in the SADC region. To achieve this goal, the programme utilizes three key levers necessary for behaviour change: (1) factually accurate HIV/SRHR information; (2) accessible youth-friendly HIV/SRHR services and support; and (3) learner agency that empowers young people to make decisions and take actions in areas that impact their lives. The important crosscutting issues of climate change and gender are integrated into all programme activities.

MIET AFRICA is SADC's technical assistance partner, supporting SADC with programme implementation at the regional level, and Member States at the country level.

This is an 11 month contract position, commencing 1 February 2021 and ending 31 December 2021. The successful applicant will be based in Malawi.

Key Performance Tasks

- Coordinate effective implementation of the FutureLife-Now! health-focused activities in Malawi
- Work closely and maintain good relationships with relevant partners, including the Ministry of Education, Health, FutureLife-Now! schools, health facilities, and other stakeholders
- Reporting to the FutureLife-Now! Country Coordinator, contribute to effective programme planning, monitoring, and reporting
- Support the FutureLife-Now! Country Coordinator in implementation of programme activities
- Support the M&E team in data collection and other M&E related activities
- Support the implementation of all components of the radio and mobile messaging programmes.

Requirements

- Relevant tertiary qualification
- Minimum three (3) years' experience working in the development sector

- Experience, knowledge and understanding of the education and/or health and development environments.
- Excellent facilitation skills
- Good communication skills, both written and verbal
- Valid and unendorsed driver's licence
- Fluency in Chichewa would be an advantage.
